## Serbian Scholarship

- Loyola University Chicago is offering a tuition scholarship for a two-year Master's degree program in the School of Education. The School of Education offers a variety of Master's Degree programs, the most relevant to this scholarship are in Curriculum and Instruction, School Administration and Supervision, and Special Education.
- One tuition scholarship will be offered to a citizen of Serbia who has graduated from a Serbian University. The student covers all non-tuition fees and other charges.
- A stipend will be offered by Ogden Public School in Chicago. This will require that the successful candidate work in their area of study at Ogden Public School during their program of graduate studies.
- The tuition scholarship will be available for the Spring 2008 semester, which begins Monday, January 14, 2008.
- International students are required to study on a full-time basis. The recipients of this scholarship will complete their master's degree program within two academic years.

- The application deadline is November 1, 2007. All application materials, including TOEFL score and transcript evaluation must be submitted by November 1, 2007. - Please note: Only prospective students holding conditional or unconditional offers of admission are eligible to apply for the tuition scholarship.
- In addition to general admission requirements (completed application form, three letters of recommendation, a current resume, a personal statement, official transcripts of all college work, etc.) International students must complete the TOEFL (minimum acceptable score is 550 Paper Based, 213 Computer Based, 79 Internet Based) and have all transcripts evaluated by ECE, [www.ece.org](http://www.ece.org). All of these materials must be received at Loyola University Chicago by November 1, 2007.
